BRISTOL'S RULES

1. WE ARE HERE TO HAVE FUN & KEEP EVERYONE SAFE. COMMON SENSE RULES! HAVE PATIENCE WITH THE CREW!

- 2. Limit of 3 Weight Classes PER TRACTOR & PER DRIVER
- 3. Full Pull = 20 ft
- 4. Any Bolt-on or Secured weights are permitted. If any weights come off as mounted while hooked to the drag, the tractor will be disqualified. The weights will be allowed to stick out no more than 30" inches from the frame or the front of the casting of the tractor.
- 5. The pulling point face will not exceed 20" in height. 20" measurement shall be at the top of the drawbar or spacer/washer, if needed.
- 6. When hooking up, tractor must be in NEUTRAL. Raise hands & remain seated during hook-up. No packing the track. No jerking of the stone boat. Tighten chain before pulling. Pay attention to the hook & flag people.
- 7. One person allowed per seat on a pulling tractor.
- 8. All tractors must have good working brakes.
- 9. Drivers under 18 must have parents express permission with signature on waiver and hitch form.
- 10. 4 wheel drive tractors will run in 2 wheel drive ONLY.
- 11. Weighing In: All tractors must be weighed prior to their class. Once weighed, line up in the staging area.
- 12. The Pulling Committee shall determine the width of the pulling area prior to the event. Once established, if any part of the tractor touches a boundary line during a pull, the puller is disqualified.
- 13. The Hook Person shall determine if tractor has achieved it's full pulling potential. In the event that the hook person is not available, a committee member shall be appointed to make the determination.
- 14. Event Officials reserve the right to add rules or correct any problems not addressed in the rules.
- 15. Disqualification due to Speed, Reckless Driving, or Alcohol = Disqualified for the Day with NO Refunds. Violations of the rules will not be tolerated.
